The charitable deeds performed by the Order of Elks remain forever a secret, but they have caused many a ray of sunshine to penetrate the dark clouds of adversity hovering over the homes of their fellowmen; they have brought sunshine to many homes and hearts that have been clouded by life's vicissitudes. Its messengers of peace and happiness visits the chambers of the sick and dying to nurse back the rosy cheek of health or cheer the lonely sufferer on his way until he shall have set foot upon the mystic shore of the great unknown, and then when the last flower has been tenderly laid on the tomb of the departed brother the hand of charity is extended to those who were nearest and dearest to him in life.

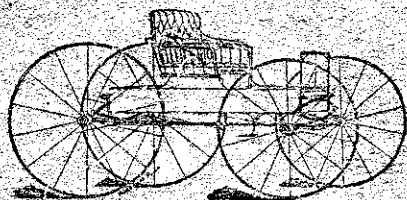
