**HOUSE RULES FOR ELKS AND GUESTS AT THE RIVER PARK AND  
CAMPGROUND**

Revision May 2009

These rules must be adhered to by all Elks and any guests at all times, whether or not an authorized Caretaker is present. Failure to comply with any requirement may be cause for the Elk to lose his Club and River Park privileges and cause for the member of non-complying guest to be asked to leave or be immediately removed from the premises.

**ELKS LODGE #699 OR NONE OF ITS MEMBERS IS RESPONSIBLE FOR  
ACCIDENTS, INJURIES, THEFT OR DAMAGE TO PERSONAL PROPERTY  
WHICH MAY OCCUR ON THE PREMISES. NO LIFEGUARDS ARE  
PROVIDED AND SWIMMING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.**

1. Members of Salisbury Elks Lodge #699 are eligible to purchase a key to open campground and other locks at a price determined by the River Park Committee. The key will be functional from May 15 to May 15. Keys are not to be loaned to other members or guests.
2. Members may utilize the park and camping facilities at no extra charge except as defined in the RATES FOR RIVER PARK CAMPING schedule or in the case of special entertainment events which may take place at the park. Sites of permanent campers are to be respected and their privacy acknowledged. **Please walk around and not thru permanent lots.**
3. Parking is not reserved except at permanent campsites. Discretion should be used so as not to block traffic patterns or interfere with others at the park. Boat trailers should be parked at the annex near the main entrance.
4. Boats may be launched at the concrete ramp and boats and trailers should be cleared from the area in a minimum amount of time to allow others to utilize the ramp and floating dock. **Watercraft are not to be tied at the dock for any excessive time and definitely not overnight. Violation of this rule could lead to suspension from the River Park.**
5. Shelter, rest rooms, showers, ice maker, permanent grills and tables are available and should be used in a caring and responsible manner to preserve the condition for everyone's continued use. The shelter may be reserved for private events or by the Lodge House Committee by clearing availability thru the River Park Committee.

6. Any trash generated is to be removed to the dumpster or taken off the premises when a member or guest departs.
7. Campfires are permissible, unless banned by Fire Marshall in times of drought. No campfire is to be abandoned or unattended.
8. Public intoxication, use of illegal substances or any disruptive behavior is not permitted on the property.
9. Loud music which may offend others is not permitted.
10. This is a family oriented park. **NUDITY OR PROFANITY ARE NOT PERMITTED.** Parents are responsible for their children and their actions at all times.
11. **NO PETS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED TO RUN FREE OR CAUSE NUISANCE. CURBING MUST BE AWAY FROM NAY ACTIVITY AREA AND POOPER-SCOOPERS MUST BE USED BY OWNERS IMMEDIATELY SHOULD THE NEED OCCUR.**
12. **FIREARMS ARE NOT PERMITTED ON THE PROPERTY**
13. N.C. Fishing laws and licensing apply.
14. The River Park Committee is open for suggestions for continued improvement to make the park as good as facility as possible for all to use. Note any suggestion you may have and give it to the Committee or drop it off at the Lodge Lounge.
